

APPLICATION AND CONDITIONS

Application to the program goes through Mercator Office, while the selection process will be carried out by both UKM and UDE. For applicants with a scholarship, other procedures may apply. The application form and more information can be obtained from Mercator Office.

The preparation courses consist of German Language Course A1, A2 & B1, as well as a course on Intercultural Communication. You will receive support during application to UDE and support for visa and accommodation arrangement in Germany. Upon completion of your last year, both credits and grades will be transferred.

COSTS DURING STUDIES AT UDE

Tuition fees: 0 € / Semester
Social contribution: 329.06 € / Semester

You have to expect to spend a minimum of 800€ to 900€ per month for your basic living expenses. How much you really spend will largely depend on your lifestyle and manner of spending. During your studies, you are allowed to work part-time to ease the financial burden.

When applying for visa without full scholarship, students are required to open a blocked account in Germany with Euro 11,208.

- 3.0 +** Six semesters of Bachelor study with a CGPA of 3.0 + (for applicants with scholarship, other rules may apply).
- B 1** GERMAN LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY B1. Courses will be taught at Mercator Office.
- 79 +** ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY TOEFL 79+ (ibt) or equivalent.
